The Gazette also thought that "would it not mat erially affect the bringing this detestable herb in to disguise, if every town would enjoin their Sel ectmen"

The Gazette's statement showed that they approved of the Boston Tea Party's Acts as well as Le xington's, and the Gazette was wondering if everyone joined together then the taxes surely would be lowered
